Two weeks before her 36th birthday, Eve Propper was diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma.



Hodgkins Lymphoma is a cancer of the lymph cells, which is more widely known as the disease Delta Goodrem battled with at the age of 18. Eve was told this particular form of cancer is generally a young person's disease, so she was pleased to still be considered as 'young'!

Eve underwent 4 months of intensive chemotherapy through the Haematology Department at Prince of Wales Hospital, then months of radiotherapy treatment in Radiation Oncology.
